Reception

Open daily from 8.30am until 6.30pm (9.00am on Sundays). There may be a manager on duty – please check the sign on the door. Out of hours, in an emergency only, please telephone 01404 841381 or the appropriate emergency service.

Shop

Open daily from 8.30am (9.00am on Sundays). Closing times are displayed in the shop window.

Available to order -

Breakfast - freshly baked baguettes, croissants, pains au chocolat and breakfast brunchies. If possible please order by closing time the day before.

During the day – pasties with a variety of fillings, sausage rolls.

Hot take away food – open from 5.30pm (not available on Sundays). Closing time displayed in the shop window. If possible please order by 5.00pm.

Tennis court

Open from 9.00am. Please book at Reception or in the shop. Equipment is available. Soft-soled shoes must be worn.

Outdoor table tennis (weather dependent)

Behind the house. Equipment available from Reception.

Ball games

These are not permitted anywhere on the park except in the designated area next to the tennis court or well away from tents in the Five Acre Field.

Badminton (weather dependent)

On the Back Lawn. Equipment available from Reception.

Adventure Play Areas

No dogs in these areas please. The aerial ropeway is designed for 11 to 16 year olds. Only one child at a time please.

Games Room

Open daily from 8.30am to 9.00pm.

Indoor Soft Play Area – in the Games Room. The key is available from Reception during opening hours. It is suitable for children aged 6 and under.

Your dog

Pets are very welcome on the park but they must be kept on a lead at all times and exercised in the forest surrounding the park. Please pick up after your dog and use any litter bin to dispose of the waste.

Tourist Information

This can be found opposite the shop and is wellstocked with leaflets and information on things to do locally. There is also a small library of books, mainly for adults.
